

## Notes on Use of DeVilbiss DMK-621 Gunner DeKups

- New design is for improved flow and lack of paint starvation in the pattern as occurs in bag style disposable cups.
- There is no liner with this design – all hard cups with lids, plus strainer in the lid. Lids can be ordered separately if cleaning and re-using the hard cup is desired. DMK-621 has a 125M strainer. A 200M style is available also: DMK-622. Extra lids order DMK-421 (125M) or DMK-422 (200M). Strainer is removable for use with primers, etc.
- 48 cups & lids per box, compared to 32 for regular DeKups.
- The DeKups adapters are different. Erik Andress is making several available N/C.
- The cups are vented so the gun cannot be used upside down.
- Although developed with water shops in mind, can also be used in a solvent shop.
- Plain storage lids are available.
- Cup has improved and very thorough selection of mixing ratio graduations.
- When applying lid, snap firmly into place with your palms.
- Attach by turning the gun upside down and lining up the notches. Twist so that the vent winds up over the fan control knob.
- Removal – drain paint from the gun head by pulling the trigger first (unplugged from the air hose). Then twist off the gun.
- If refilling the cup is needed, position the lid slightly cockeyed, leaning the vent against the cup rim. There will be some paint draining out of the strainer, so try to leave the lid in the cup while adding more paint.
- A cup lid plug is available. No part number. Ask Erik Andress or Bob Stahmann.
